



Composer of the month: March Claude Debussy

Claude Debussy (1862–1918) was a 20th-century French composer and one of the most remarkable figures working within the field of impressionist music. As a child, Debussy was fascinated by visual art, and as he grew up, he loved the new style called "Impressionism." Instead of painting realistic life, like paintings with hard outlines, Impressionists used thousands of dots, or many different shades of color to create the "impression" of what they wanted to depict. Debussy took that idea and applied it to music, creating Impressionism in music.
